

**HILL 'N HOLLOW QUILT GUILD  
LOTTO BLOCK - NOVEMBER, 2009  
BUCKEYE BEAUTY (12-1/2"  
Unfinished Block)**

**FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:**

*ASSORTED LIGHTS:*

4 Sets of One 2" X 9" Strip and One Matching 3-7/8" Square

*ASSORTED MEDIUM AND DARK PRINTS:*

4 - 2" X 9" Strips

4 - 3-7/8" Square

**ASSEMBLE HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLE & FOUR PATCH BLOCK:**

1. Using (1) 3-7/8" square from assorted lights, and (1) 3-7/8" square from assorted medium and dark prints, make a half-square triangle. This will yield 2 blocks - should be 3-1/2" square including seam allowances.
2. Using the same light fabric that you used in half-square triangle, take the 2" x 9" strip and a **different** 2" x 9" strip of medium/dark fabric, and make (2) four-patch units. These should be 3-1/2" square, including seam allowances.
3. Referring to **Diagram 1**, layout triangle-squares and four-patch units in pairs. Sew together pieces in each pair; press seams toward four-patch units. Join pairs to make a Buckeye Beauty unit; press seams clockwise. The Buckeye Beauty unit should be 6-1/2" square, including seam allowances.
4. Repeat steps 1 thru 3 to make a total of 4 Buckeye Beauty units total.
5. Referring to **Diagram 2**, layout four Buckeye Beauty units in pairs, rotating units as shown. Join units in each pair. Press seams in opposite directions.
6. Join pairs to make a block. The block should be 12-1/2" square including seam allowances.

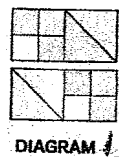

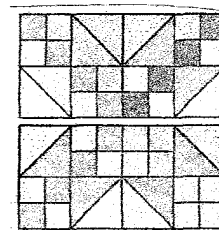
