Black & White Pinwheels

You will need:

- (2) – 6 inch squares Black-on-White
- (2) – 6 inch squares White-on-Black

On the backside of the two light squares, draw a diagonal line from one corner to an opposite corner, dividing the square into 2 triangles. Do not cut apart yet.

Layer a light square on top of a dark square, with right sides together. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ inch on each side of the line you drew. Repeat for the remaining light and dark square.

Cut both sets apart on the line you drew. Press the 4 pieces toward the dark fabric. Following the diagram below, piece the four squares together.

Your block should be $10 \frac{3}{4}$ inches square when you are finished.
