

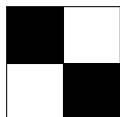
Hill N Hollow Quilt Guild

Black, White & Bright
Thrifty Block
(first published in 1939 by the Kansas City Star)
9 ½ inch block

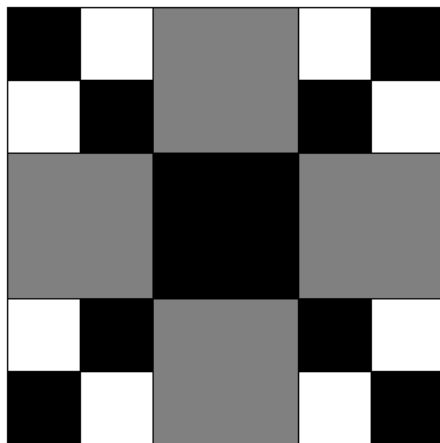
You will need:

- (1) – 3 ½ inch square Black Fabric
- (8) – 2 inch squares Black Fabric
- (8) – 2 inch squares White Fabric
- (4) – 3 ½ inch squares Bright Fabric

Using the 2 inch black & white squares, piece together the four-patch squares – you will have four of them.



Piece the four-patch squares together with the remaining black square and the bright squares as shown below:



Be careful that your black blocks make an X through the block.

Your colors do not have to be solids – they may be black-on-whites, white-on-blacks, white-on-white, as long as they “read” black and white and do not blend together.
