QUILT SHOW REGISTRATION



Art & Innovative Quilts

Original or non-traditional design

Design innovation

Skillful use of color, fabric, image or shape

Step beyond tradition in construction and appearance

Do not replicate the work of another



QUILT SHOW CATEGORIES



Traditional Quilts

Based on traditional patterns and settings

If it's not an art quilt, it's traditional



QUILT SHOW CATEGORIES



Divided by Size

Bed Quilts – 60-110” wide X 80” or more long

Wall Quilts – 24-59” wide X 24-80” long

Small Quilts – up to 24” wide X up to 24” long



ART AND TRADITIONAL QUILTS



Divided by Technique

Pieced – Primarily pieced without appliqué or embellishment

Appliqué – Primarily appliquéd, but sections may be pieced together

Mixed techniques – Displays two or more techniques or styles (i.e. piecing and appliqué), where one technique comprises 25% or more of the quilt



ART AND TRADITIONAL QUILTS



Miniature Quilts

Up to 24" wide X up to 24" long

Scaled-down version of a larger quilt design

Blocks no larger than 4" square



OTHER CATEGORIES



Embroidered Quilts – any size

Machine-embroidered quilts

or

Hand embroidered quilts

Quilts made primarily using this technique to create the quilt top



OTHER CATEGORIES



First Quilts – any size

Quilts made by **beginners**

Typically, a person's first quilt

Could be your first quilt show entry



OTHER CATEGORIES



Group Quilts – any size

Quilts made by three or more quilters

Includes round robins, block exchanges

Includes quilts made from antique blocks

Only one ribbon per quilt will be awarded



OTHER CATEGORIES



Challenge Quilts – any size

Quilts made for the Hill ‘N Hollow guild challenges

Limited to 2007, 2008 and 2009 challenge quilts



OTHER CATEGORIES

Kit/BOM/Pre-Printed Panel – any size

Quilts where design and fabric choices have been pre-selected for the quilt-maker

Includes kits

Includes block-of-the-month quilts, except the guild's 2009 intermediate and advanced BOM quilts

Includes quilts made using panels or “cheater” cloth

OTHER CATEGORIES



Wearable Art

Articles of clothing made using quilting techniques

Garments that use a sweatshirt as a foundation



OTHER CATEGORIES



Accessories/Home Décor/3-D Projects

Functional or decorative quilted objects like:

Table linens (must submit at least 2 placemats)

Christmas stockings or tree skirts

Door hangings

Purses and tote bags

Boxes

Whimsical Foundations/Bras for the Cause

Decorate a bra according to a theme of your choice!

Bras will be auctioned; proceeds benefit Peitz Cancer Support House

OTHER CATEGORIES



Special Exhibits

Quilt tops and other examples of projects created through the guild's programs, including classes and workshops

This category will not be judged

OTHER CATEGORIES



Other Non-Judged Items

Quilted items other than Whimsical Foundations and Special Exhibits that the exhibitor wants to display but does not want to have judged



OTHER CATEGORIES



Quilts must be clean

Quilts must be labeled with the owner's name

Every quilt, wall hanging and miniature must have a sleeve

Top of the sleeve no more than 90" from bottom

Split sleeves for large quilts

Sleeves must be 4" deep on any quilt > 24" wide

Non-members will pay \$5 per item and for insurance



Limit of 3 entries per category

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS



Ribbons

1st, 2nd, 3rd places


Honorable Mentions

No automatic awards; one item in a category will receive a ribbon only if the judge deems it worthy

New for 2009: You must include with your entry form a photograph showing the main portion of your quilt for identification purposes

Any entry may be offered for sale.

Guild retains a 11% donation on all sales (16% for non-members and members who do not work at least two hours before, during or after the show).

Sales will run through the Country Store and will include sales tax.

QUILT SALES

Guild will provide insurance for quilts in its possession at the Baxter Country Fairgrounds

Schedule of Coverage

Quilts with a perimeter of 350" or more -- \$500

Quilts with a perimeter of 250"-349" -- \$400

Quilts with a perimeter of 150" – 249" -- \$200

Quilts with a perimeter of 149" or less, wearable art, accessories, home décor items -- \$100

You may purchase additional insurance for 60 cents per \$100 stated value; appraisal required
