Workshop: Radiant Feathered Star

Date: Thursday, March 10, 2011

Description: learn to draft, rotary cut and machine piece this wonderful 15" Radiant Star Feathered Star block. Make it in red and green, if you like, and use it as a holiday banner, a table runner or quilt. We will use the bias-strip piecing method to piece the small triangles.

Texts: (It is not necessary to have these to complete the workshop.)

1. *Feathered Star Quilt Blocks 1*
2. *Quick Classic Quilts*

Supply List for Students:

- Rotary cutter with new blade
- Cutting mat
- Rulers (recommended: 8" Bias Square© cutting ruler from Martingale or Marsha's Feathered Star ruler, the Omnigrid 6" X 24" ruler, 3" X 18" ruler and 15" square)
- Fabric: Bring ½ yard of light background print or solid, and assorted colors (at least a fat quarter of solid-looking dark, a solid-looking medium and a multi-color medium scale print) Bring more fabrics and colors if you like.
- 18" C-Thru drawing ruler (B-85) Office supply store often carry these.
- Sharp pencil
- Eraser
- Colored pencils
- Compass
- Sewing machine in good working condition
- Small zipper type bags
- Normal sewing supplies
